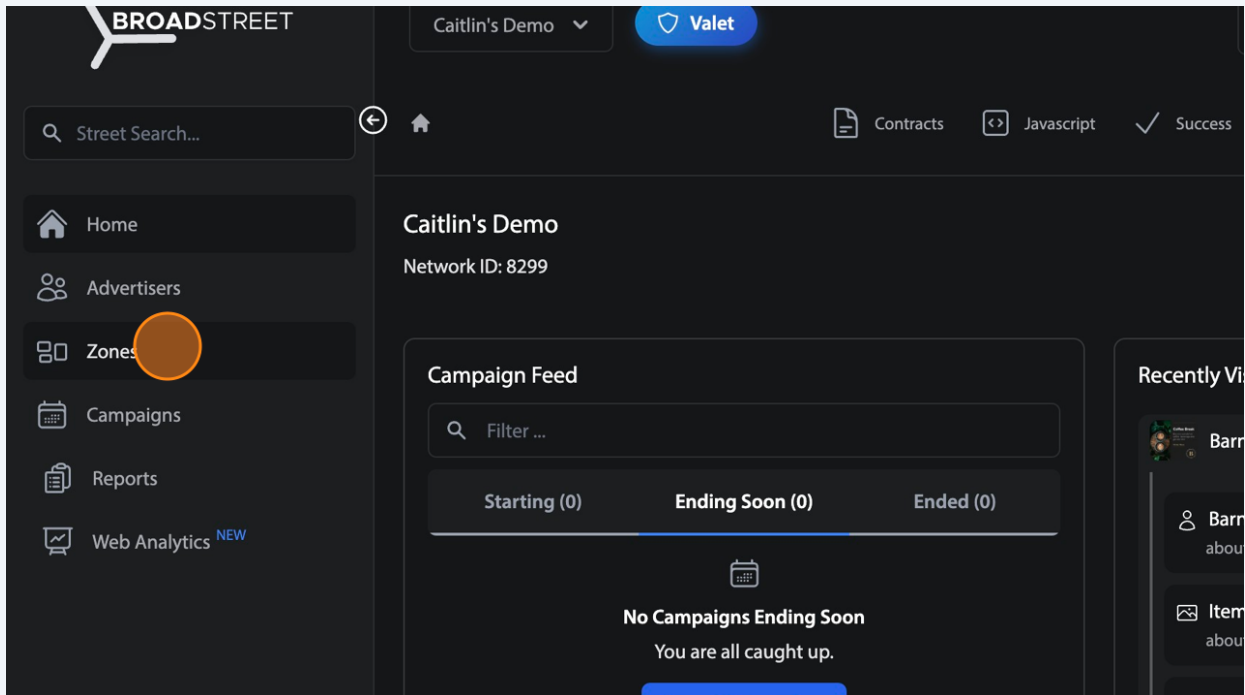





Rotating Ads on an Interval
